Minutes of the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Examinations of Institute of Engineering & Management, Kolkata held in online mode on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022 at 10:30 a.m.

Agenda 7.1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of Board of Examinations held on 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2022.

The minutes of the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of examination was read out by the Controller of Examinations, IEM and approved by all members.

Agenda 7.2: To recommend the result of Even Semester Examination 2022 of B.Tech., BBA, BCA, MBA, MCA, M.Tech. and M.Sc students for approval by the Chairman, Governing Body.

Even Semester Examination result 2022 (Autonomous) of B.Tech. BBA, BCA, MBA, MCA, M.Tech. and M.Sc. students have been approved by the Board of Examinations and have been sent to the Governing Body for approval and publication of results.

Presentation of result analysis of the Even Semester Examination 2022 was given by the Controller of Examinations, IEM. Result Analysis was also presented to the Board Members. The marks analysis to be sent to respective departments for feedback and remedial measures to be taken on the basis of the feedback.

Respective departments should do a thorough study of the result analysis and take a note of the measures they should take in the teaching learning process. The study report to be mailed to the COE section by the departments.

Proposal was put by the Director regarding the implementation of a relative grading system, much like in IITs. The members expressed their interest in the proposal, and suggested that the relative grading system be put to a pilot test internally on existing data instead of a full-fledged implementation and infer its viability and requirements. The member noted that a policy change in the grading system shall have to be notified through proper channels to the affiliated university authorities.

The members note that since the affiliated university already uses absolute grading with grace if required on a case to case basis, for all its streams and subjects, it is prudent to follow the methods until further analysis can be done.

## Agenda 7.3: Any other matter with the permission of the chair.

The members suggested that a tracking analysis be done for the topper students over the duration of the upcoming semesters.



The members pointed out that an analysis of the results based on the facts that similar subjects may have similar patterns of results, may be done to identify the root-cause of any failing grades. It was suggested that this may aid in taking better remedial measures in upcoming similar subjects for a batch.

The members suggested that another Board of Examination meeting be held after a period of time to discuss the feedback and actions reports received by the departments.

The meeting was concluded by the Controller of Examinations by thanking all the members of the Board of Examinations, IEM.
