LATERAL ENTRY SCHEME



In pursuance of the scheme of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the State Government in the Higher Education Department has extended the scope of degree level Engineering Education to the diploma holders through the introduction of 'Lateral Entry Scheme' for admission of the diploma holders in Engineering /Technology/ Pharmacy directly into the 2nd Year /3rd semester of 4-Years degree course effectively from the academic session of 2001-2002. Under this scheme, diploma holders from AICTE approved Polytechnic Institutions with at least 45% marks (40% in case of reserve category students) in aggregate in appropriate branch of engineering /technology /pharmacy are eligible for admission through State Level Common Entrance Test (named as JELET) conducted by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board. The intake capacity is up to the extent of 20% of the total approved intake along with the vacant seats of the first year. However, students having passed

B.Sc. degree from a recognized University as defined by the UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% in case of reserve category students) and passed XII standard with mathematics as a subject are also eligible for admission under the Scheme as per guidelines provided by the AICTE.
